Additionally, all GLIDDEN SPRED exterior paints provide a mildew resistant coating and can be applied in low temperatures (above 35°F) which allow you to extend the painting season with confidence.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Fill all holes, cracks or open joints with caulk • Lightly sand glossy areas.

Make sure all areas are clean, sound and free of flaking paint or any substances such as oil, grease, dirt...anything that will get between your siding and your paint. Prepare *Previously Painted Surfaces* with this product or **GLIDDEN** Prime Exteriors PC3000 acrylic primer/sealer.

IT IS TIME TO PRIME - PREPARING UNPAINTED SURFACES

WOOD - Sand lightly to a smooth surface, then prime woods prone to cracking such as yellow pine or T-1-11 plywood siding with this product or **GLIDDEN** Prime Exteriors PC3000 acrylic primer/sealer. Prime tannin containing woods such as redwood or cedar with **GLIDDEN** Prime Exteriors PC3000 acrylic primer/sealer.

CONCRETE, PLASTER AND MASONRY - Cure for 30 days before painting. "Slick poured" or pre-cast concrete needs chemical

cleaning or a light sandblasting. Thoroughly rinse with water and allow to fully dry. Remove loose aggregate and prime with a **GLIDDEN** primer. For concrete block, fill with a **GLIDDEN** block filler.

STEEL, GALVANIZED METAL AND ALUMINUM - Clean off oils, then prime with a GLIDDEN primer.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

QUALITY TOOLS FOR A QUALITY JOB

Use a 1/2" or larger nap roller and a nylon or polyester brush/paint pad for siding • For trim use 1/2" or small nap roller • May also be applied using airless spray with a .015" to .017" tip at 2000 to 2500 psi pressure.

LET'S GET PAINTING

Mix thoroughly • Apply at package consistency • Thin with 1/2 pint water per gallon if necessary only when using a sprayer • Make sure the air, paint and the surface you are painting are above 35° F • Do not paint if rain, snow, heavy dew or lower temperatures are expected within two hours of painting • Apply generously, no

overspreading • Certain colors may require more than one coat for complete hide.

- 1. Stir with a lifting motion for uniform color.
- 2. Dampen roller slightly with water.
- 3. Paint all trim including, windows, shutters & door frames first.
- 4. Begin at highest point, working towards the ground.

LET'S CLEAN UP

Clean hands and tools with warm, soapy water • Clean spills right away with a damp cloth • After 30 days or paint has fully cured, areas may be washed with a non-abrasive, mild detergent.
